



NFRC MEMBERS RECOGNISED AT NHIC AWARDS

The 40th National Home Improvement Council (NHIC) awards took place on Thursday, 13th November in London.

Since 1974 the NHIC Annual Awards have recognised achievement in the UK housing arena and have grown over the years to become the premier event in their sector. In recent years the awards scheme has attracted entries from across the spectrum of housing modernisation projects as well as associated activities such as energy efficiency, renewable technologies, safety and design.

NFRC as ardent supporters of NHIC sponsored the Excellence in Roofing award, which this year was won by NFRC trade member, <u>Karl Terry Roofing Contractors Limited</u> based in Kent for their restoration of Frog's Hall. There were two runners-up for this category; <u>Traditional Roofing and Building Ltd</u> for the refurbishment and energy efficiency upgrade of a city centre building and <u>Claude N Smith Ltd</u> for the re-slating of an 18th Century Grade II listed cottage.

CompetentRoofer, the Competent Person Scheme for Self-certification for Roof Refurbishment and is run by NFRC, also sponsored an award at the event. The merit award which recognised the promotion of CompetentRoofer, to the housing association sector, was presented to <u>Jackson Jackson & Sons</u> who had since joining the scheme had saved their clients some £500,000 in administration costs.
