In addition apprenticeships are available for more mature entrants allowing people of all ages to develop a skill either as a result of upskilling or transferring to a new industry. Our company has through the years employed a number of adult apprentices and we currently have a final year adult apprentice.

This aspect of apprenticeships is often overlooked.

Employing apprentices allows us to develop our workforce by training people to the standard that we require. The industry is currently experiencing a skills shortage and we consider part of addressing this for the future is to encourage young people into the industry by offering trades apprenticeships.
