COMPETITORS SELECTED FOR ROOFING FINAL AT SKILLBUILD

The finalists for this year's SkillBuild competition have now been chosen and we look to the final which will be taking place at Preston College from the $12^{th} - 14^{th}$ September. Competitors will be battling for first place in the following roofing disciplines; Slating and Tiling, Sheeting and Cladding, Single Ply and Reinforced Bitumen Roofing.

However, for them to have been selected to compete in the finals the trainee roofers had to either go through heats or via an equally tough selection process; all to ensure that they meet the standards required.

Heats for Roof Slating and Tiling were held in Bolton, St Austell, Erith, Birmingham, Newcastle, Leeds, Arbroath, East Kilbride and Inchinnan and in all involved sixty competitors across the four disciplines. All competitors had to tackle a six-hour practical piece of work which was designed to test them for skill, speed and temperament, all qualities which will be needed in the finals.

The heats and the selection process were organised in conjunction with the National Construction College, the Single Ply Roofing Association, and the numerous colleges affiliated with NFRC. The materials were once again kindly supplied by our sponsor SIG Roofing and Roofline.

The roofing competitions at SkillBuild have always had a tradition of being high in quality with competitors coming from all parts of the UK, and to ensure that continues, only those amongst the high scorers will make the finals this year, with a maximum of two per heat going through.

We wish all competitors, their employers and colleges the very best of luck for the finals would encourage all readers to come along to see some of the best young roofers in the UK ply their trade at the finals.
