

## SAFETY IN ROOFING AWARDS ANNOUNCED

The Safety in Roofing Awards has been in operation for many years to promote a positive attitude towards health and safety amongst NFRC member companies. Trade members are invited to enter these awards. The information the company supplies is based on its health and safety training and accident statistics from 1<sup>st</sup> January to 31<sup>st</sup> December. The awards are then externally marked by an independent panel of health and safety experts and a selection of entries are randomly audited.

Trade members are presented with either a gold, silver or bronze award at their Regional AGMs which start later this month. The best entries receive recognition at the Roofing Awards lunch. These are the members with the highest percentage scored nationally with the slating and tiling, sheeting and cladding and flat roofing disciplines.
